Old Business

Spring Clean Up Day - Update

The Spring Clean Up Day took place on Sunday, May 31, 2026, from 9 AM to 12 PM. Chairman Moetzinger stated this marked the third cleanup day for Montebello, and the number of volunteers exceeded that of previous events. Volunteers from North Rockland, Clarkstown, and our own Village participated, comprising a diverse group of children and adults of all ages. A total of over twenty-four bags of trash and more than four bags of recycling were collected. Chairman Moetzinger is already in the process of planning the next fall cleanup day, given the significant success that each cleanup brings to the village.

Jazz Festival

KGPP Update

Ongoing Park issues persist, including exposed wires, a sinkhole at the entrance near the dam, and erosion of the spillway along Senator Levy Drive area.

The installation of additional trash cans, particularly near the gazebo, along with the potential purchase of pool skimmers to assist in removing debris from the ponds. Furthermore, the placement of no smoking signs, especially around the gazebo, if they are not there already.
